

INSTRUCTION FOR THE APPLICATION OF JT COVER

Please read and follow these guidelines before applying the element in order to ensure a tight cover.

- Inspect the surface of the liquid on which you will use JT Cover:
 Neither must there be a natural floating cover nor any items or obstacles which would prevent the JT Cover elements from spreading on the surface and floating together.
- II. Check that the openings in the tank, pond or basin are smaller than the diameter of the JT Cover. Otherwise the elements could get stuck in the openings and block them.
- III. **JT Cover** can be applied to **an empty tank.** Yet it is necessary to do this very carefully so that the elements will not be damaged.
- IV. JT Cover can be **poured directly from the big bag into the tank, pond or basin.** The easiest way to apply JT Cover is to turn the big bag upside-down and hold it over the surface. You can open the big bag by pulling the cord at its opening.
- V. **For your safety:** Make sure that you never work alone. There should **at least be one additional person present** to help you applying the elements. Avoid any risk of falling into the tank, pond or basin buy securing everybody involved in the work.
- VI. At the beginning only 70-80 % of the delivered quantity should be poured onto the liquid. The elements must have enough space to spread and then float together which will be prevented by overfilling the tank. After 1-2 weeks further elements must be added where the surface is not covered yet. Be aware, that "less is more" avoid overfilling. After another week the cover should be examined again to see if it is necessary to add more elements.
- VII. When using mixers, pumps or suction pipes make sure to keep a safety distance to the floating elements of at least one meter. Else JT Cover can be damaged.
